BEREC Opinion Intra-EU communication Regulation

Background

- The current regulation expires on 14 May 2024
- EC, with the support of BEREC, assesses the existing measures and determines whether and to what extent there is an ongoing need to reduce the caps
- This opinion is based on: (a) data collected by BEREC, (b) short call for input, (c) other available data



Main Findings

- The regulation supported price decrease but no significant impact on the consumption
- OTT applications broadly used for cross-border communications. Some limitation for users above 55 years old
- Difference between roaming and intra-EU pricing might not be easily understandable for consumers
- The current price caps are significantly higher than a rough estimate of the costs required to offer intra-EEA calls. Issues might arise from SMS termination and transit.



BEREC Opinion FUP and Sustainability

Main conclusions – FUP Measures

- FUP has been used to prevent anomalous usage
- RLAH+ volumes are very low → consumer benefit from RLAH
- Very few complaints about FUP measures → consumers are well informed
- Most effective FUP measure: Open data bundle limit
- Other FUP measures used less because of complex implementation



Main conclusions – Derogation

- Derogation ensures sustainability of domestic charging models
- Decline of number of derogations \square also because decreasing wholesale rates
- Few declines of derogation applications, mainly because of incomplete data
- No evidence of increased prices for domestic or RoW services because of 3% margin



Main conclusions – Areas for improvement

- Room for simplifying rules – but technical implementation costs should be considered
- Open data limit: FUP should not exceed domestic allowance
- Pre-pay limits / other objective indicators → EC could consider to remove them from the CIR
