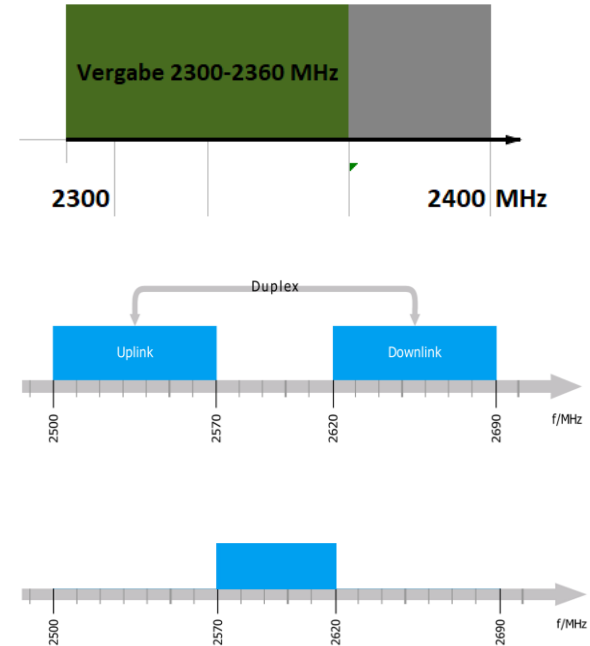

 - Für Mobilfunk neu gewidmet
 - TDD
 - 60 MHz verfügbar
- **2600 MHz**
 - 2010 vergeben, Nutzungsrechte laufen Ende 2026 aus
 - FDD: 2x70 MHz
 - TDD: 50 MHz verfügbar (40 MHz nutzbar)
